

ÖIF-Parenting Courses: Orientation and support in the Austrian school system

The “summer school”, which was implemented by the Ministry of Education for the first time in 2020, will continue in the summer vacation of 2021. In addition to the summer school, the Austrian Integration Fund (ÖIF) will once again offer a 3-hour course for parents and guardians whose children are attending the summer school in 2021. The ÖIF parenting course provide knowledge and orientation about the educational landscape in Austria and the success of your child in school.

The ÖIF parenting courses take place between May 17th and September 10th and are offered throughout Austria. The courses are led by certified ÖIF trainers. ÖIF interpreters are called in if necessary. The offer is free of charge for all participants.

In the parenting courses you will get important information about...

- the summer school 2021 (including content, goals, opportunities),
- the basics of the Austrian education and school system,
- further training and educational opportunities for young people after compulsory education (including apprenticeships, school leaving examinations, advisory centers in the region),
- the importance of the involvement of parents and legal guardians in the educational career of their children (including compulsory education, function of parents-teachers conference, availability and constructive communication with educators, the use of Schoolfox),
- support and funding opportunities for children and adolescents (among other things about learning difficulties, preparation for starting school, learning German) and
- German learning opportunities for parents and legal guardians.
